Implementation of the Financial Reporting System on Grand Megane Optik

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ABSTRACT

This article discusses the analysis of the financial reporting system at the Grand Megane Optik company in Jember Regency. The purpose of this article is to explore the financial reporting system used in financial management at the Jember branch of the Grand Megane Optik company. The research method used in this article is a qualitative descriptive method with data collection through interviews, observation and document analysis. The research results show that in the financial reports of the Jember branch of the Grand Megane Optik company, this company uses the Excel application and the Point of Sales (POS) application to produce monthly financial reports which will then be sent to the head office in Surabaya. In conclusion, this article shows that the Jember branch of the Grand Megane Optik company is considering using more modern and computerized software for their business management by using POS applications to improve efficiency and business management. Thus, companies can improve their business performance and gain greater profits in the future.

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1. INTRODUCTION




Figure 1. POS application as a basis for preparing financial reports Source: Grand Megane Optik Jember, 2023

The research results show that Grand Megane Optik Jember branch uses a financial reporting system consisting of the use of Excel and Point of Sales (POS) applications. The data presented in the financial reporting system has been processed using the Excel application and input into the program every month. Using the Excel application allows companies to record and manage various financial information, such as sales, stock of goods and other transactions. Apart from that, Grand Megane Optik Jember branch also uses the Point of Sales (POS) application in business operations and preparing financial reports. Point of Sales is an application used by cashiers to operate the business and prepare financial reports. The POS application is used by cashiers to enter sales or purchase transactions. The steps for the Grand Megane Optik Jember Branch cashier to enter transactions in the Point of Sales (POS) system are as follows:
